| EPHESUS = Relaxation Rev.2: 1-7. | He that holdeth the seven stars in his right hand, who walketh in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks. | I know thy works and thy labour and thy patience....thou canst not bear them that are evil....thou hast tried them which say they are apostles and are not and hast found them liars, and hast borne and hast patience, and for my names sake hast laboured and hast not fainted.....thou hatest the deeds of the Nicolaitans. | Nevertheless I have somewhat against thee because thou hast left thy first love. | Remember therefore from whence thou art fallen, and repent and do the first works. | Or else, I will come unto thee, quickly, and will remove thy candlestick out of his place except thou repent. | He that hath an ear let him hear what the spirit saith to the Ecclesias | To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God. |
| SMYRNA = Myrrh, Bitterness. Rev. 2: 8-11. | The first and the last, which was dead and is alive. | I know thy works and tribulation and poverty (but thou art rich) and I know the blasphemy of them which say they are Jews and are not, but are the synagogue of Satan. | Behold the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that ye may be tried and ye shall have tribulation ten days. | Fear none of those things which thou shalt suffer. | Be thou faithful unto death and I will give thee a crown of life. | He that hath an ear, etc. | He that overcometh shall not be hurt of the second death. |
| PERGAMOS = A Tower, Earthly strength. Rev. 2: 12-17. | He which hath the sharp sword with two edges. | I know thy works and where thou dwellest, even where Satan's seat is, and thou holdest fast my name, and hast not denied my faith, even in those days wherein Antipas was my faithful martyr. | But I have a few things against thee, because thou hast there them that hold the doctrine of Balaam...them also that hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans, which thing I hate. | Repent | Or else I will come unto thee quickly and will fight against thee with the sword of my mouth. | He that hath an ear, etc. | To him that overcometh will I give to eat of the hidden manna, and will give him a white stone, and in the stone a new name written, which no man knoweth, saving he that receiveth it. |
| THYATIRA = She that is unwearied in Sacrifices. Rev. 2: 18-29. | The Son of God, who hath his eyes like a flame of fire and His feet are like fine brass. | I know thy works and charity and service and faith and patience and thy works, and the last to be more than the first. | Notwithstanding I have a few things against thee...thou sufferest that woman Jezebel...to teach and seduce my servants...I will kill her children with death and all the Ecclesias shall know that I am He that searcheth the reins and the hearts. | I will give unto every one of you according to your works. But unto.....the rest in Thyatira, as many as have not this doctrine, and which have not known the depths of Satan...I will put upon you none other burden. | But that which ye have already, hold fast till I come. | Promise to overcomers | Call to Hearken |

Rev. 3: 1-5 | He that hath the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars. | I know thy works that thou hast a name, that thou livest and art dead.....Thou hast a few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments; and they shall walk with me in white; for they are worthy. | I have not found thy works perfect before God. | Be watchful and strengthen the things that remain, that are ready to die....Remember, therefore how thou hast received and heard, and hold fast and repent. | If therefore thou shalt not watch, I will come on thee as a thief, and thou shalt not know what hour I will come upon thee. | He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels. | He that hath an ear, etc. |
| PHILADELPHIA = Brotherly Love. Rev. 3: 6-12 | He that is holy, He that is true, He that hath the key of David, He that openeth and no man shutteth, and shutteth and no man openeth. | I know thy works. Behold, I have set before thee an open door and no man can shut it, for thou hast a little strength and hast kept my word and hast not denied my name. | Behold, I will make them of the synagogue of Satan, which say they are Jews, and are not, but do lie; behold, I will make them to come and worship before thy feet, and to know that I have loved thee. | Because thou hast kept the word of my patience, I will also keep thee from the hour of temptation which shall come upon all the world to try them that dwell upon the earth. | Behold, I come quickly, hold that fast which thou hast that no man take thy crown. | Him that overcometh will I make a pillar in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out; and I will write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God; and I will write upon him my new name. | He that hath an ear, etc. |
